## **S) SAFE**

- Never engage in sexual relationships with minors
- Minors under 10 must be supervised by a designated adult

- Over the age of 15 is responsible to help with move-in and show strike
- Is expected to follow Code of Conduct
- Is expected to positively represent and support WCT
